FEES & FINES

Please remember that no student will be able to compete, participate, or even practice if they owe a fee or fine to the high school.

If your student owes a fine, please contact the high school office to speak with an administrator to arrange for payment *prior to* the sports season.

Additionally, when writing checks, they must be for the exact amount only AND be same day bankable. Checks written for more than the amount due **WILL NOT** be accepted as the bookkeeping office does not make change. VISA, MasterCard and debit cards are also accepted, in person only.

ATHLETIC PARTICIPATION

Any new student to Vallivue High School wishing to participate in athletics must have a physical **prior to** the first day of tryouts. The Idaho High School Activities Association Health Examination form, necessary for a sports physical, is available in the school's main office as well as on the district website in the sports link.

2010-2011 REGISTRATION COSTS

Listed below are some of the costs that may be incurred for registering a student at Vallivue High School.

- ASB Card.....\$35.00
*(Any student involved in athletics, band, choir or an extra curricular activity **MUST** purchase this card.)*
- Yearbook.....\$60.00
- Regular ID Card/Student Agenda.....FREE
(There is a \$5 replacement fee for each of these items, while supplies last.)

Online registration is accessible through the Vallivue website beginning August 10th. However, keep in mind that this registration process is not all inclusive and is strictly for payments only.

Once again, students will not be taking their photo identification picture at registration. This will be done on Friday, August 27th which is picture day. Students will receive their photo id/activity card on this day.

The bookkeeping office accepts VISA/MasterCard and debit cards (in person only), cash and checks. **Checks must be written for the exact amount of purchase only AND be same day bankable. Postdated checks will not be accepted.** Checks must have the current address and phone number imprinted on them.



INCOMING SENIORS

Dorian Studio will again be providing both your senior yearbook photo and the hall wall plaque photo. **This is a requirement for ALL SENIORS** due to previous submissions of poor quality photos, photos which did not meet specifications as well as the cost of photos to seniors. This procedure ensures that all seniors are able to have photos included and that all photos meet yearbook specifications.

Senior Formal Picture Day will be Monday, September 13th. The senior picture retake day is Monday, October 18th AND this is also the LAST opportunity for senior yearbook and wall plaque submission pictures to be taken.
