

Vallivue Middle School – Uniform Dress Code

The School Uniform Dress Code will: encourage students to experience a greater sense of school identity and belonging; improve student behavior; increase program participation and provide a safer school environment.

All students must have shirts tucked in and belts on before entering any building. All clothing must be clean and maintained in good condition at all times; no holes, no stains, no fringes, and no loose hems.

Shirts:

- Only polo style shirts permitted
 - Solid Colors: white (must wear white undershirt), chocolate brown, gold, tan, yellows
 - short or long sleeve, hemmed
 - two, three, or four buttons at the top front with collar
- Shirts are to be tucked in and must be long enough to stay tucked in
- Under-shirts and t-shirts, if worn, must be white in color, and can only be worn underneath the polo shirt
- Not allowed: designs, emblems, insignias, monograms, or logos of any kind

Slacks:

(Cannot be more than 1 size larger than student's current size)

- Solid color: black, khaki, or brown
- ***Straight legged pants only!***
- If the clothing has belt loops, a belt must be worn (loops cannot be removed)
- (Not allowed): tapered or "skinny" pants, or tight below the knee
- Cargo style allowed (boys and girls)
- Can be pleated or flat front
- Must be worn at waistline (elastic waist permitted)
- No elastic or gathering at the ankles. No slits in pant legs.
- Length not to exceed bottom of shoes
- Not allowed: designs, emblems, insignias, monograms, or logos of any kind
- Not allowed: corduroy, brushed corduroy, velvet, brushed velvet, denim, sweatshirt material, fleece, or ***tight fitting below the knee***

Skirts:

(Cannot be more than 1 size larger than student's current size)

- Solid color: black, khaki, or brown
- Must be worn at waistline (elastic waist permitted)
- If the skirt has belt loops, a belt must be worn (loops cannot be removed)
- Can be pleated, flat, or A-line
- Length: ***top of knee or longer***
- Not allowed: designs, emblems, insignias, monograms, or logos of any kind
- Not allowed: corduroy, brushed corduroy, velvet, brushed velvet, denim, sweatshirt material, or fleece

Shorts/Skorts/Capri and Crop Pants:

(Cannot be more than 1 size larger than student's current size)

- Solid color: black, khaki, or brown

- Cargo style allowed (boys and girls)
- Must be worn at the waistline (elastic waist permitted)
- If the clothing has belt loops, a belt must be worn (loops cannot be removed)
- Can be pleated, flat, or A-line
- Length: ***no shorter than four (4) inches above knee*** (hem line can be cuffed or not cuffed)
- Not allowed: designs, emblems, insignias, monograms, or logos of any kind
- Not allowed: corduroy, brushed corduroy, velvet, brushed velvet, **denim**, fleece, sweatshirt material or tight fitting below the knee

Belt:

- Belts are mandatory for any article of clothing with belt loops (belt loops cannot be removed)
- Solid color and solid material in fabric, leather or vinyl: **black**, **Khaki**, or **brown**
- Belt buckle must be a plain standard buckle
- Not allowed: hanging belts, designs, emblems, insignias, monograms, logos of any kind, studs, imprints, etc.

Socks/Tights/Leggings:

- **Solid color**: white, **black**, **khaki**, or **brown**
- Not allowed: designs, emblems, insignias, monograms, and logos of any kind

Shoes:

- Shoes may be tie, buckle, Velcro, or slip on
- Shoes will be properly tied, if applicable
- Shoe laces must match shoes/shoe style
- Not allowed: bedroom or lounge slippers

Sweater/Sweatshirt/Vest:

VMS ONLY - ALL sweaters/sweatshirts/vests ON CAMPUS must follow uniform policy!

(Cannot be more than 1 size larger than student's current size)

- Solid color: **chocolate brown**, **khaki**, **golds**, **yellows**, or **grey**
- Polo shirt collar needs to be visible
- May be pullover or front zipper style
- Made of **one layer only**
- May be hooded
- Not allowed: designs, emblems, insignias, monograms, and logos of any kind
 - **Exception**: Vallivue School District sponsored logos are acceptable

Coats:

- Coats/jackets: CANNOT be worn in the buildings (must be kept in locker)
- Coats/jackets: style is personal choice
- **No TRENCHCOATS allowed on campus!**

Headgear:

- Stocking caps\hats in **polo** colors only
- Not allowed: designs, emblems, insignias, monograms, and logos
 - Allowed: Vallivue School District Logo's
- Not allowed: headgear worn inside the buildings at anytime
