

## THE SCOPE OF THE WORK

The *Library/Research Skills and Technology Curriculum* is a joint effort between Middleton School District 134 and Vallivue School District 139.

The curriculum writers prepared a matrix of objectives. Vallivue teacher representatives from all grade levels and from a variety of subject areas joined media generalists in Q-Sorting the objectives between December 8, 2004 and May 11, 2005. Recommended changes were made, and the revised objectives, in the form of an articulation matrix, were sent electronically to all teachers for validation on May 19. The curriculum was approved June 7 by the District Supervisory Committee (G-6), who recommended the curriculum for adoption by the Vallivue Board of Trustees.

The curriculum objectives are correlated to the national literacy standards and indicators (*National Information Literacy Standards for Student Learning* prepared by the American Association of School Librarians and Association for Educational Communications and Technology, ©1998). In addition, as resources are aligned and lessons are developed, they will be correlated to the Idaho Achievement Standards and district curricula.

Librarians/media generalists and teachers will work together to expand the curriculum document by developing lessons and instructional calendars to guide implementation. In addition, resources from a variety of subject areas will be aligned to the objectives. The resulting document will be different from other district curriculum documents in that it is written for both classroom teachers and librarians/media generalists.
