

DRESS FOR SUCCESS

SAGE VALLEY MIDDLE SCHOOL STUDENT UNIFORM CODE

The School Uniform Dress Code will: encourage students to experience a greater sense of school identity and belonging; improve student behavior; increase program participation and provide a safer school environment. Teachers may request that no sweatshirt/sweaters be worn in their classroom.

All students must have:

- lanyard/ID cards visible at all times
- shirts tucked in
- belts on
- no hats
- no designs, emblems, insignias, monograms and logos of any kind.
- All clothing cleaned and maintained in good condition at all times; no holes, no stains, no rips, no fringes, and no loose hems.

Shirt:

- **Polo:** Solid, navy, white, tan, or green
- Undershirt: White only (no thermals)
- White polos must be worn with a white t-shirt

Skirt/Shorts/Skort/Slacks/Capri and Crop Pants:

- Solid color: black, khaki, or navy
- No skinny style, jean or corduroy material
- Must be worn at waistline
- **Skirts:** knee length or longer
- **Shorts/Skort:** 4 inches above knee or longer

Belt:

- Solid color and solid material in black, khaki, or brown
- Belt buckle must be a plain standard buckle
- Must be worn with belt loops
- Appropriate length for waist size, no dangling belts

Socks/Tights/Leggings:

- Solid color: white, black, khaki, or navy

Shoes:

- Shoes may be tie, buckle, Velcro, or slip on
- Shoes will be properly tied, if applicable
- Shoe laces must match shoes/shoe style
- No bedroom slippers

Sweater/Sweatshirt

(Cannot be more than 1 size larger than student's current size)

*Definition: One layer of material

- Solid color: navy, khaki, white, green, or grey
- May be worn in classroom with polo collar revealed
- Official Sage or Vallivue sweatshirt only in the above colors

Lanyards & ID cards:

- Plain lanyards in navy, green or white
- Lanyard replacement \$3.00/ID replacement \$5.00
- Defaced ID cards will be confiscated and student will be required to purchase a new one

Outerwear:

- Outerwear may not be worn to class (must be kept in locker)
- No **TRENCHCOATS** allowed on campus!
- Outerwear may be any color with and without hoods.

Caps/Hats/Scarves/Gloves:

- Not allowed in building at anytime.
- Not to be worn as an accessory

Consequences:

If a student wears inappropriate clothing he/she will be required to call home and have appropriate clothes brought to him/her.
