The Main Pathway

**2.0 cumulative yearly

The Alternate Pathway

**1st Semester Credit
Recovery: PLATO or
Individualized Plan and pass
semester assessment
(Grades 7 – 8)**

**Earn *Basic* or above on
Language, Math, and
Reading ISAT (Grades 6 – 8)**

**Must pass 3rd and 4th
quarter assessments
(Grades 6 – 8)**

**Must complete summer
school with a "C" average
or better. (Grades 6 – 8)
Recover lost credits in
summer school and
pass semester assessment
(Grades 7 – 8)**

- Use your student agenda.
- Work hard and use your time wisely.
- Think and ask questions that will help you understand assignments.
- Struggling with course work, ask for help!
- Attend Success Club after school if you need help.
- Teachers may assign extra work, make up work, or time at Success Club to help you achieve your goals.
- Students in danger of not meeting the requirements will meet with the promotion committee. (principal, teacher, counselor, and parent) to discuss required steps to reach academic success. Parents are expected to participate in this meeting. Results of the meeting will be communicated to the student and parents. A copy will be put in the school cumulative folder.
- Students cannot miss more than 6 days per semester. Students missing more than 12 days per year will need to petition the promotion committee.

Then

*Students in grades 7 – 8 will not be allowed to lose a full year of credit in one area and move to the next grade level.
*Students on and IEP or a 504 will have the guidance of the IEP team.
*LEP/Migrant students' progress will be reviewed by the Promotion Committee.
